


Child-Friendly Behaviour Policy

What do we want our school to be like?

At our school positive behaviour is being respectful and kind towards everyone and following the Rainbow Rules and the School Rules.

"Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord" - Colossians 3:23





What are the consequences for not following the Rainbow Rules and School Rules?

<u>Step 1</u>

Positive praise given to those who are behaving appropriately.

<u>Step 2</u>

Verbal warning given with reasoning.

<u>Step 3</u>

Warning given with reasoning.

<u>Step 4</u>

If a child receives **3 'warnings'** in a week, parents will be informed via a phone call from their class teacher. They will also miss their next break (maximum 15 minutes), during which time they will be asked to **'reflect'** on any inappropriate behaviour, supported by the relevant Key Stage Lead.

This policy was developed by a group of 6 children.
